

January was Sanctity of Life Month

On January 22, 1984, President Ronald Reagan issued a presidential proclamation designating the third Sunday of January (or close to that) as National Sanctity of Human Life Day. So what has happened since then:

Last summer, the Supreme Court made the landmark decision to overturn the 1973 abortion case, Roe v Wade. Before its overturning, abortion was legal for anyone in the United States, including teenagers. Now the legality of abortion is in the hands of each of the fifty states. 13 states have banned abortion, 11



states have made restrictions stronger, and some allow abortions through the 9th month.

Currently this administration is stripping away every federal regulation to make it easy as possible for a mother in any state to self-administer what's called a "chemical abortion" or self managed care in spite of the Roe reversal. What are "chemical abortions"? The truth is that 54% of all abortions are already conducted this way. In states such as Texas that has banned abortions, a doctor in a state hundreds of miles away can prescribe for a woman the abortion pills, in some cases without so much as a positive test. Then the abortion pills are sent through the mail and the woman is left to administer these dangerous drugs to herself with no medical supervision present. The law states the doctors prescribing the pills must be the one to send them. That was until January 3rd of this year. This administration and the FDA removed that restriction and now have allowed the local pharmacies to sell these pills. The woman must still have the prescription from an abortion doctor but she can go to the local CVS or Walgreens and pick her pills up. No longer waiting on the mail. Women have lost their lives and have suffered complications from this self managed care program. If a woman has severe pain or severe bleeding she can go to an emergency room for care but think about what she is going through usually alone.

Together, we can bring the darkness of the abortion industry into the light—to fight it and to bring attention to the sanctity of all human life.

From Our Files:

- 1. A young lady came in with the boyfriend. They were very much abortion minded but stayed over two hours speaking with the volunteer. Occasionally she would have to stop because she felt sick. They asked many questions. Finally the woman shared that at 17 (she is now 27) she had an abortion. Her parents made her or else she had to find another place to live. She still lives with them and knows they will have the same issue with this pregnancy. The volunteer felt after the two hours that they were waiting on her to give them any ideas on how to get an abortion since Texas has an abortion ban. She was worn down and frustrated. But continued to give positive encouragement. They took a break outside and came back in smelling of alcohol. They left saying abortion is the answer but thanked us for our encouragement.
- 2. A woman in her late 20's with a 5 year old nonverbal autistic child was not happy with positive result. She has no family support with the autistic child. The father of this baby is not supportive as well. She is considering abortion since she will be left to do it all. She does have a very good job, the child attends school in a special class which gives her a much needed break. She does attend Lakewood church. Adoption information was shared. She is extremely quiet and tearful of this situation.
- 3. A woman that had been with us before came in for another test. Her youngest being only 3 months old. With the positive result she immediately started crying saying his family will not be happy and will give them grief. This will make baby number four. She said she was thinking about abortion but immediately decided she would be the one to live with that decision rather than his family. His family is very stressful and feel they can give advise for all the decisions. She said she also had post partum with the last baby. She did have the baby and when she came in for her layette she said she is overwhelmed.
- 4. We get many women who thought they were complete with their family only to find out another child is on the way. Usually it is a shock at first then what will my family and friends say? What will my older kids say? Many times the women are in their late 30's and early 40's. Many are happy once the shock wears off but others are faced making a decision they thought they would never have to make. They are concerned with their age, finances, and what others think.
